



## A five-week interactive workshop for toddlers and their caregivers

Come ready to play! This workshop is just as hands-on for the parent as it is for the toddler. The room will be set up for a range of different “learning-through-play” options for your toddler, and we encourage parents to follow their child’s lead to where and how they want to play. The focus of this program is to help parents identify new and individualized ways they can play the role of their child’s first and most important teacher.



Different resource specialists are available to parents each week of the workshop. Specialists will be available to discuss early literacy, speech and language development, child development, nutrition, and play and movement.



Unlike Storytime, 1\*2\*3 PlaySmart is not a drop-in program, and we ask participants to commit to attend all five weeks of the workshop series, barring illness.

1\*2\*3 PlaySmart is held twice a year. Interest cards and information for the fall workshop are available toward the end of August and for the spring workshop toward the end of January. Contact the library or watch the newsletter around these times to see when the interest cards are available. Interest cards are not registration forms. Space is limited, so participants selected to participate are notified a week or two prior to the first session.
