



Fun & Games With

BUILD a tower using a few different sizes and shapes of blocks. Have your child build a matching tower.



CUT rectangles, squares, and circles from paper. Have your child glue the shapes to make a construction vehicle.

MAKE a painter's tape outline of a tower that shows different size and shape blocks. Have your child build the tower.

SING: (tune "Pop Goes the Weasel.") Hammers, pliers, saws, and nails. Tape measures and ladders. Who uses all these tools?
The construction worker!

PROVIDE paint brushes and tubs of water for your child to "paint" a fence, outside wall, or sidewalk.

PROVIDE toy tools for your child to cut, hammer, and roll out the sand play dough.

SAY construction-related words, such as *bulldozer*, *excavator*, *bricklayer*. Have your child repeat the word, hammering for each word part. (Example: 3 taps for *bricklayer*.)

MIX sand, flour, water, and baby oil to make sand play dough.

CREATE a construction sensory bin with construction vehicle toys and pebbles, sand, or beans.

PUT TOGETHER a builder's snack using pretzel sticks and mini marshmallows to create a structure.
