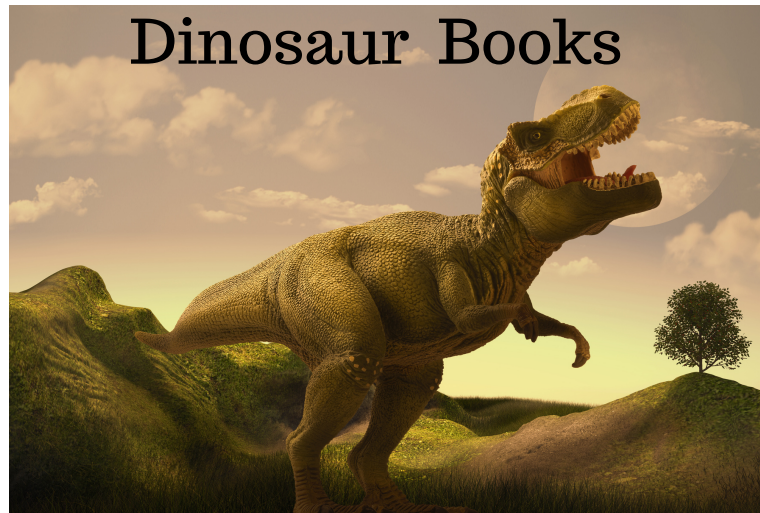
## Fun & Games With

SING "The Dino Pokey" where children put in arms to scratch, feet to stomp, tails to swing, and teeth to chomp.

DRAW or download the outline of a dinosaur. Have children glue pasta shapes (especially penne) to look like bones.

CREATE pretend fossil tracks by having your child press the feet of dinosaur toys into craft dough.

SET UP a fossil dig bin with dinosaur skeleton toys, rocks, and sand. Add a paintbrush to remove sand.



### Dinosaur Books

DECORATE two long tissue boxes to look like dinosaur feet and have your child wear them, pretending to be a dinosaur.

IMITATE dinosaur movements such as stomping, swinging their tail, chomping, running, and moving together in herds.

CREATE dinosaur eggs (many recipes online) or simply put small dinosaur toys or cutouts into plastic eggs.

SHARE dinosaur facts with your child, such as *T-rex had teeth the size of bananas and actually had feathers!*

MEASURE dinosaur toys' height by building Lego towers as tall as each toy.

PLAY "Dinosaur or Not?" Some species such as Pteradactyl, Dimetrodon, and Mososaurus are not actually dinosaurs!

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
