



# Fun & Games With

SING songs about farms, such as "Old MacDonald," and "Oat, Peas, Beans and Barley Grow."

DRAW or download a sheep outline. Have children glue popped popcorn or cotton balls to the drawing.

TALK ABOUT how your food goes from farm to store.

SET UP a sensory bin with popcorn kernels, potting soil, or oatmeal and farm toys.



## Farm Books

TAKE TURNS acting out farm animal movements (without sounds) and naming the animal.

BUILD barns, fences, and pens with blocks.

CREATE shaker eggs by filling plastic eggs with rice and taping closed. Use with sing alongs.

COUNT the number of animals on a page in the book.

SAY nursery rhymes about farms, such as "Little Boy Blue" and "This Little Piggy Went to Market."

SORT animal pictures or toys according to whether or not the animal lives on a farm.
